EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES



A Better Chance works with three types of educational institutions: day schools, boarding schools, and Community Schools Programs (CSPs).

INDEPENDENT DAY SCHOOLS

Scholars live at home and commute to independent schools for classes & school activities.

INDEPENDENT BOARDING SCHOOLS

Scholars live away from home in a campus dormitory and attend classes on campus.

COMMUNITY SCHOOLS PROGRAM (CSP)

Community Schools Programs (CSPs) are independent 501(c)(3)s that allow Scholars to live away from home in a suburban community and attend a high-performing public school.
